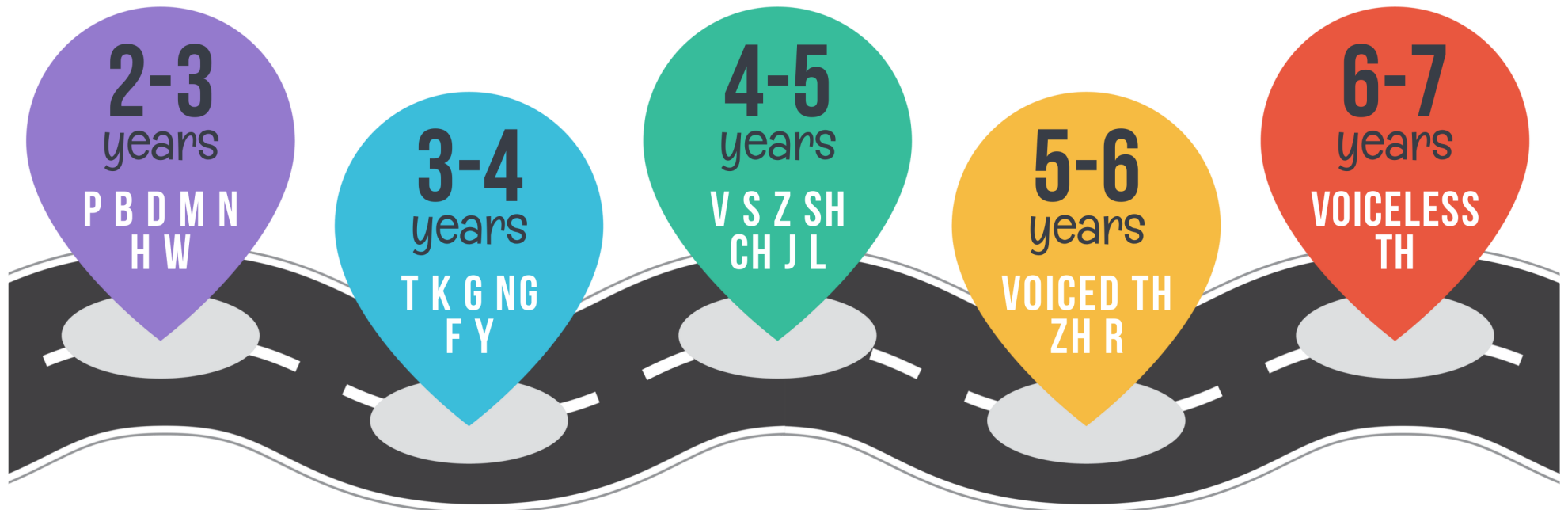


SPEECH SOUND development

Average age that 90% of English-speaking children in the U.S.
correctly produce speech sounds.



Voiced TH is the "buzzy" TH sound (as in "they," "weather," and "bathe.")
Voiceless TH is the "quiet" TH sound (as in "think," "python," and "math.")
